SUMMARY OF POSITION

Our field technicians are responsible for supporting our Operations and Engineering team. They are responsible for installing low voltage (structured) cabling, surveillance, and access control equipment, with the potential to occasionally assist in other low voltage projects. They are required to be registered with the NC Alarm Systems licensing board (background check and fingerprinting.)

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Load and unload service vehicles, tools, project equipment and project specific materials
- Pull and terminate CAT6, Access Control and Other Various Wire Gauges
- Mount Cameras, Sensors, and Access Control Units
- Installation of Electrified Strikes, Electrified Deadlatch, Magnetic Locks and Door Hardware
- Installation of Egress devices, Keypads/Card Readers, and Power Supplies
- Knowledge and understanding of power tools: Hammer Drills, Oscillating tool, various saws, Cut-Off/Grinder and open to learning new tools
- Conduit, Junction box, and cable pathway installation
- Operate service Vehicles, Mechanical lifts and trailers
- Inventory Management
- Read drawings and follow installation instructions, determine and confirm optimal equipment placement if not specified to follow NC codes and meet customer needs
- Required to adhere to BAS safety protocols and guidelines

- Ability to work out-of-town and stay overnight when scheduled for projects that are more than 1 hour from BAS office.
- Familiarity with HVAC systems and integration within a BAS environment.
